Old Business

1. Certification classes

1. Agendas for future workshops

• Kassandra stated that timely and interesting topics on the agenda are important and it may be wiser to only offer 2 meeting a year to do this.

- Kim suggested the Board come up with a list of topics for future workshops and thinks there is enough information to share to keep 3 meetings a year.

1. FIPA shirts

- Janet DeBiasio researched and ordered socially responsible t-shirts for all of the members that have the FIPA logo. The FIPA will give each member one shirt and sell additional shirts for \$10.00.

Members will have to provide sizes and payment prior to the ordering of the shirts. The FIPA will pick up part of the cost and pass the rest along to members.
- The idea was raised to check into securing a sponsor for the golf shirts. Everyone thought that was a good idea and we will explore the possibility.

1. Status of the IP Awards

• There are currently 3 awards given. The FIPA would like to change it to an individual award, a group or program award and has discussed a FOG award. Qualifications and criteria will be discussed and developed in the future. We hope to have the changes implemented and in place for 2007 awards.

1. LLIDS

• The FIPA was approached to take over the development and ultimately the distribution of LLIDS. The current software is written in visual basic. Anthony is going to take a look at it. The FIPA is willing to try to finish the development of the software but feels that finding a person to devote the time may be difficult. Bob Heilman is going to try and secure a grant to complete the project. With funding we may be able to hire someone to get it done.
