Required Minimum Qualifications Industrial Pretreatment "C" Level

The Florida Industrial Pretreatment Association (FIPA) conducts training courses and exams for voluntary certifications in Industrial Pretreatment and Fats, Oils & Grease Program Management. Courses are open to industrial pretreatment professionals, laboratory personnel, and water/wastewater operators. By completing a 2-day course, an individual may earn 1.6 Continuing Education Units (CEUs) issued through accredited organizations.

Required minimum qualifications for Industrial Pretreatment "C" Level (Basic) Exam & Voluntary Certification Issuance:

- 1. Must have accumulated 1 year experience in industrial pretreatment, wastewater collection or treatment, water/reclaimed water distribution or treatment, and/or laboratory sampling or analysis
- 2. Must successfully complete the Industrial Pretreatment "C" course through FIPA or FWPCOA
- 3. Must achieve a grade of 70% or greater on the "C" course certification exam
